As you know, we have had an extraordinary amount of rain this winter season.

In fact, one of the master planned developers on Oahu recently noted that their construction crew typically has 60 rain out days a year.

Last year, this increased dramatically to approximately **160** rain out days.

As much as we all love how green everything is after it rains, muddy ground and rainy weather prevented the contractor from performing the foundation work.

Current estimates are that new home delivery dates will see a significant slowdown of approximately two months before they can pick up the pace again.

In order to provide a baseline date for your planning purposes, a letter will be mailed to you when your slab is poured. The builder estimates about four to five months (once slab is poured) to complete the construction of your home.

Both Royal Contracting and Kaya Builders are working hard to deliver your home at the earliest time possible.

Please continue anticipating the possibility of delays as there are a myriad of items that impact delivery and are outside of the developer's control.
